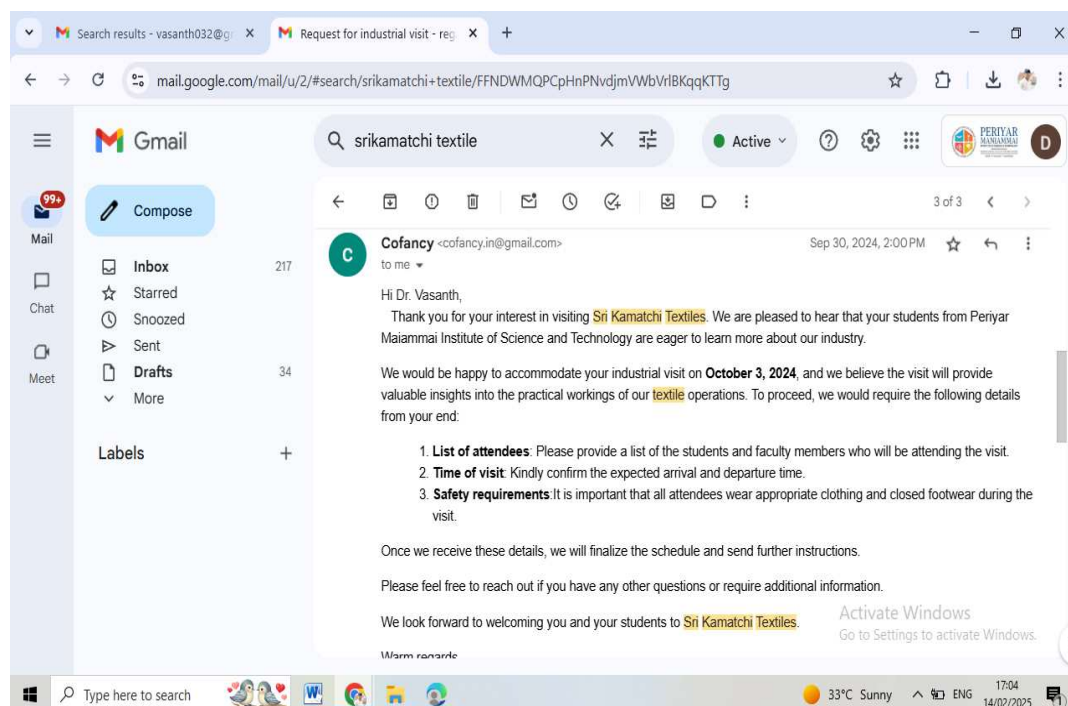
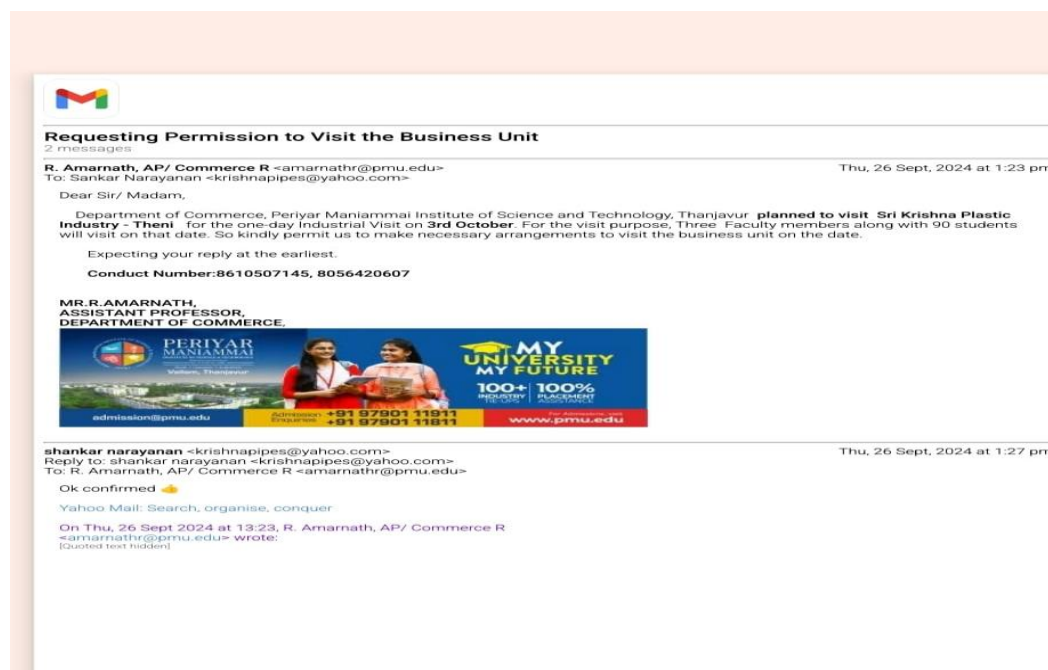


During the visit, students were taken through the various stages of textile production.


