REPORT:

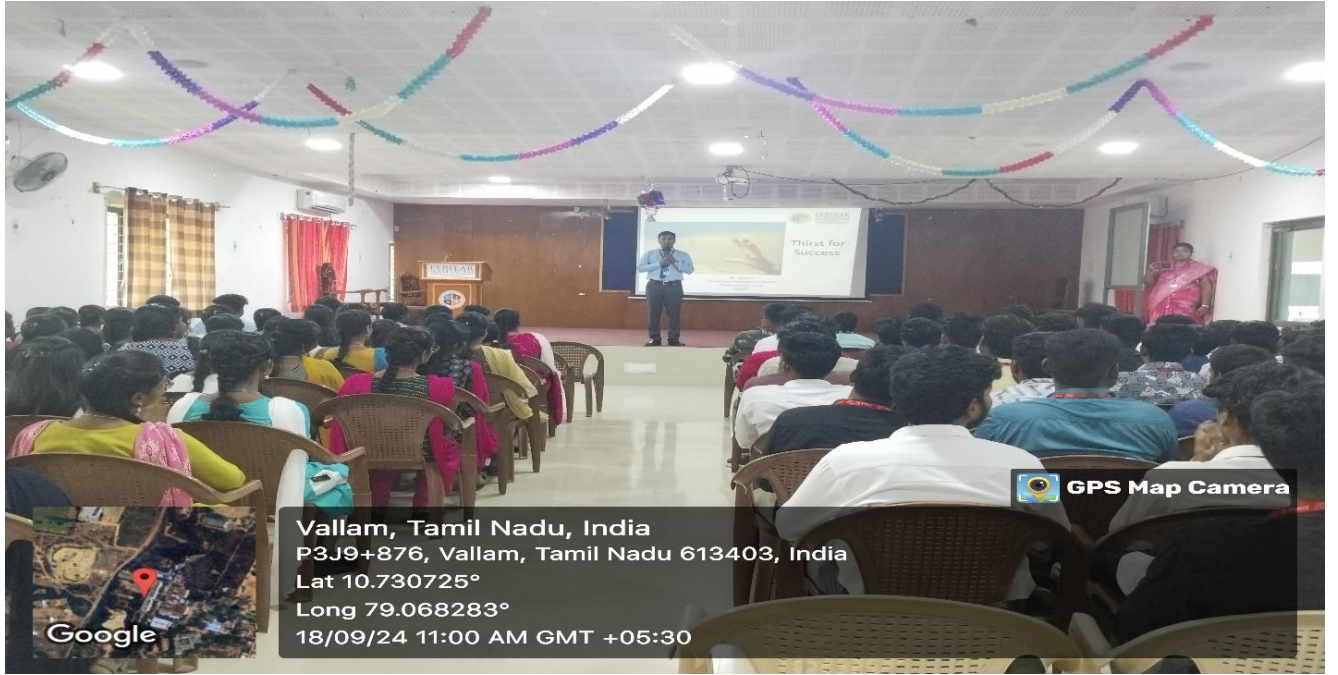

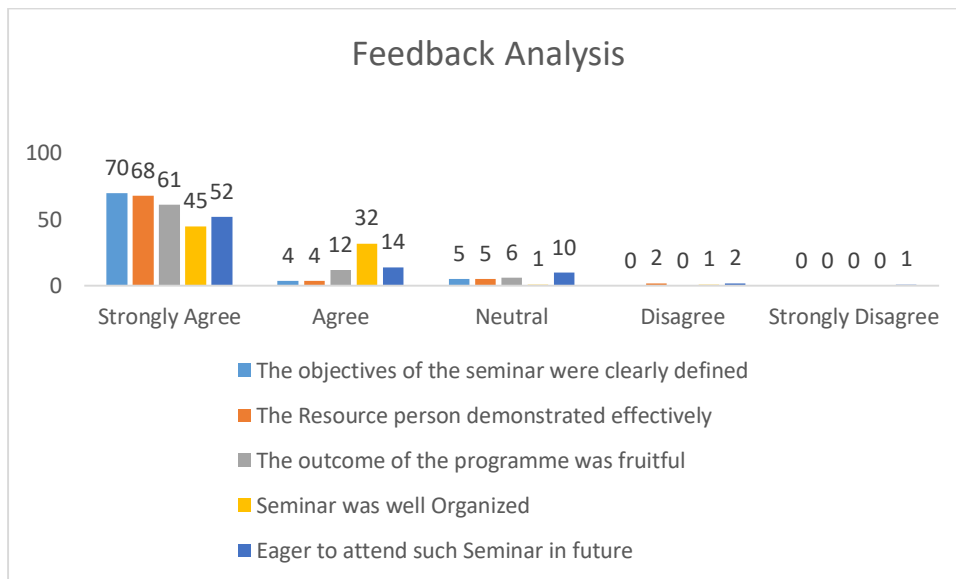
