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

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## **1. Introduction:**

The Periyar Maniammai Institute of Science & Technology (Deemed to be University), Thanjavur, stands as a testament to the enduring legacy of social reform and educational empowerment. Named after Thanthai Periyar, and his visionary partner, Annai Maniammaiar, the institution was founded with a bold mission—to break barriers and promote inclusive quality education.

Proudly recognized as the world’s first women’s engineering college, established as Periyar Maniammai College of Technology for Women in the year 1988, and elevated as University in the year 2007 under Section 3 of UGC Act 1956, the Institution continues to uphold its founding values.

Under the inspiring leadership of our esteemed Chancellor, Dr. K. Veeramani, a lifelong advocate for social justice, the Institution remains committed to academic excellence, innovation, and the betterment of society. This annual report reflects our continued journey of progress, achievements, and unwavering dedication to shaping a more equitable future through education, research and extension activities.

## **2. Academic Activities and other details:**

### **2.1 Establishment of Faculties and New Departments:**

PMIST has undergone a significant academic restructuring, increasing the number of faculties from four to six, aiming to enhance administrative efficiency, improve academic focus, and better serve the needs of students and the wider community. The six faculties are Faculty of Architecture and Planning, Faculty of Engineering and Technology, Faculty of Science and Humanities, Faculty of Computing Science and Applications, Faculty of Commerce and Faculty of Management Studies.

As part of the academic restructuring, two new departments namely Department of Informatics and Department of Foundation Courses have been established.

## **2.2 Educational System & Curriculum:**

As part of the academic enhancement initiative, New Regulations 2024 has been introduced and based on the same the Curriculum has been completely revised and approved for all the programmes offered by the Institute and implemented from the academic year 2024–2025 onwards. The changes are aimed at aligning the academic structure with contemporary educational standards, ensuring improved learning outcomes, and preparing students to meet the evolving demands of industry and society.

In addition, PMIST now offers a one-of-a-kind dual degree programme designed to equip students with core competence in Computer Science along with an additional degree in advanced expertise in Artificial Intelligence and Data Science, starting from this academic year. This unique dual degree programme is ideal for students seeking to stay ahead in the competitive, tech-driven world and enhance their careers through specialization in two high-demand domains simultaneously.

## **2.3 Programmes Offered:**

PMIST offers a total of 53 degree programmes, in various disciplines like Architecture, Engineering and Technology, Science and Humanities, Management Studies and Commerce constituting 33 UG programmes, 20 PG programmes and 19 Ph.D. programmes.

## **2.4 Admission:**

2225 students have been admitted during the academic year 2024-2025 as per the norms of AICTE, UGC, NCERT, and Council of Architecture.

## **2.5 Student Strength:**

In the academic year 2024–2025, a total of 6172 students are enrolled across various Undergraduate (U.G.), Postgraduate (P.G.), and Doctoral (Ph.D.) programmes.

- UG Programmes: 1522 female students and 3518 male students
- PG Programmes: 481 female students and 469 male students
- Ph.D. Programme: 88 female students and 94 male students

## **2.6 Examination and Evaluation:**

Examination system consists of Continuous Assessment (CA) and End Semester Examinations (ESE) under Outcome Based Education (OBE) pattern for all UG and PG Programmes. In accordance with the Ph.D. regulations, the prescribed evaluation pattern for the Ph.D. program is being duly followed.

## **2.7 Evaluation of Performance:**

To our credit, every semester results are published within fifteen days after the exam and the results will be uploaded on the institute's website for the visibility of students and parents.

## **2.8 Graduated Students:**

About 1416 students from various disciplines had cleared the final examination held in April / May 2024 and graduated in the year 2024-2025. Thirteen research scholars had completed their Ph.D. viva-voce during the year 2024.

### **10.1 Activities of Clubs and Societies:**

PMIST has 14 Clubs and Societies in total. Under these clubs, 27 programmes were organized and about 1999 students benefited out of the activities conducted by various Clubs and Societies. In addition, domain specific clubs are established under every department.

### **10.2 National Cadet Corps (NCC):**

- 24 cadets successfully completed their “C “certificate examination and 27 cadets successfully completed their” B” Certificate examination.
- Army Cadet Gopinath of II BCA and Army cadet Yazhini.G of II B.A Political Science has successfully participated in the 76<sup>th</sup> Republic Day function at Delhi Rajpath. Cadet Gopinath.S and was selected to represent Tamil Nadu cultural Team as an Instrument player.

## **11. Periyar Technology Business Incubator (PTBI)**

- Pneumatically Operated Electronic Multipurpose Simulator (POEMS) - simulator gun for training the shoulder-mounted missile launcher gun operations was designed and prototyped by CETAT in 2016. Periyar TBI bagged the contract for commercial production of these simulators in 2022. After three years of rigorous tests and trials by IAF, POEMS was finally inducted into the Service of Indian Air Force on March 27, 2025.
- Institute of Aeronautics, Astronautics & Aviation has chosen Periyar TBI as best Start-Up Incubator for promoting drone and other air-space Start-Ups; a prestigious award received during their celebration of International Civil Aviation Day on 4<sup>th</sup> December 2024.
- Host Institute Status of PMIST for Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME) - BI scheme of MSME was approved by the Project Monitoring and Approval Committee of the Ministry.
- Periyar TBI is empanelled as a Knowledge Partner for the Innovation Voucher Programme (IVP) of Entrepreneurship Development and Innovation Institute, Tamil Nadu (EDII-TN), a State Govt. programme to seed fund innovations. Through this status, student innovations can be mentored for incubation.
